Scope of Position

The DAC of Fun ensures that all members are having fun in their Scouting roles. They help with events and ideas so that volunteering and participation is enjoyable and meaningful.

Responsibilities

- Visit sections to bring cheer to members who are without
- Bring issues of concern to the attention of Section Scouters, Group Committee or the Area Service Team
- Make sure that members are kept aware of progress made towards addressing their concerns

Communications

- Attend Area committee meetings to facilitate two way communication with sections
- Attend Red Arrow to share fun ideas with other Scouters
- Encourage Section Scouters to participate in Red Arrow and Area events

Program Support

- Mentor Section Scouters to make sure program is Youth Led and loads of fun on the Canadian Path
- Mentor Group Committee members to help their sections to maximize fun, minimize frustration and remember that they should be having fun too
