

Sunset Area Report – September, 2018

Membership:

As of Sept 11th, 2018, SSA has 90 youth and 49 volunteers registered for the 2018-19 Scouting Year. This is a youth decrease of 46.7% and a volunteer decrease of 29%, for a net membership decrease of 41.6%.

PQA:

11 out of the 30 sections in SSA achieved the PQA standard, which is now reflected in the section profile in MyScouts with the PQA icon.

Group Capacity:

SSA currently has 25% of its Groups with three or more non-section Scouters.

Safety:

SSA has a very good volunteer readiness state, with only 8 Pending Scouters, most of whom are undergoing renewal or screening processes.

Volunteer Support:

Sunset Area continues to seek an Area Commissioner whose position has been vacant since last winter. The CK3 is currently supporting SSA, and will be holding an Area Meeting on Sept 23rd in Formosa. This will be the first Area meeting for 2018-19.

Items of Interest:

Camp Charl'Bro is currently not accepting bookings due to the resignation of the Camp Chair, resulting in our inability to ensure safety and property compliance of the facility. In order for Charl'Bro to continue, a new camp chair must be identified and onboarded.
